SPECIFIC CALL FOR APPLICANTS AT MASTERS LEVEL, IN THE FIELD OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND ECONOMIC GOVERNANCE

The International Fellowships Program (IFP) is a program based in New York, and supported by the Ford Foundation. It is administered in Tanzania as IFP-Tanzania in collaboration with the Economic and Social Research Foundation (ESRF).

In addition to the prevailing Application Announcement, this is a Specific Call by IFP-Tanzania for applications for up to two years of study to Masters levels of exceptional individuals with potential qualities in the fields of Economic Development and Economic Governance and who will use their education to further development in their own communities and the nation, ultimately bringing about greater social and economic justice in the country and also worldwide.

If awarded, the fellowships are tenable any where in the world, where the IFP programme has collaboration with Strategic Partnership Universities (SUPs).

The selected candidates in the field of Economic Development and Economic Governance will be part of the Seventeen (17) to be awarded scholarships for the 2011/2012 academic year to undertake **MASTERS PROGRAMME ONLY**.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicant must

- Be resident or resident nationals of Tanzania or other official resident of Tanzania
- Hold an honors bachelor's degree- for those applying for Masters Fellowships
- Have demonstrated leadership skills and commitment to community service and/or national development.
- Have significant relevant professional or other work experience related to proposed field of study, of not less than three (3) years.
- Intent to pursue a post-graduate degree that will directly enhance their leadership capacity in an academic, policy, practical or artistic discipline and field corresponding to one or more of the Foundation's areas of endeavor.
- Present a plan specifying how they will apply their studies to social problems in their own countries.
- Commit themselves to working on these issues after completing the fellowship period.

Special Notes:

- Priority will be given to people living and working with communities outside the major cities or
- Applicants working with marginalized groups in rural or urban poor.
- Applicants are cautioned that background checks would be run on short-listed candidates.
- Applications must be **specifically labeled** on top of the envelope to indicate the degree being applied is "MASTERS IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT "OR "MASTERS IN ECONOMIC GOVERNANCE "

Deadline for applications of this announcement is not later than 5.00 p.m. on Friday 26th February 2010. Late applications will NOT be processed.
